

Safe Management at Live Events

This is our flagship course which is run over 4 days and is aimed at Event Managers and operations staff with health and safety responsibilities. It has now become the basic course in the events industry for all event management staff and is also recommended for Event Directors who have limited operational experience. The course delivers a basic grounding in health and safety law and covers event risk assessment in detail.

Delegates must pass a 40 minute written test and complete a risk assessment project within 10 working days of the course to certify. Successful delegates will be awarded a photo ID certificard.
