

Safety Principles of Temporary & Demountable Structures at Live Events

This is a one day course aimed principally at operations staff in the events and exhibitions industry who work with temporary structures and space only exhibition stands. Delegates should ideally have already completed the IOSH Safe Management at Live Events Course or be scheduled to attend it and have some operational experience at events and exhibitions.

In house courses cost £1,200 plus £50 per delegate.

Places on open courses are available at £400 per delegate.

Objectives

At the end of the course delegates will:

- have a broad understanding of the principles of the effects of loads on temporary structures
- be able to identify the problems associated with poor structural design
- understand the requirements for granting approvals to temporary and complex structures
- be able to contribute to the stand approval process.

Course Content

- **Module 1** - The importance of formal checks on structural safety
- **Module 2** - The basics of structural design of TDS
- **Module 3** - Problems Associated with Poor Structural Design and Construction
- **Module 4** - Structural auditing, approval and certification process
- Final exercise to draw on lessons from the whole day. Delegates are presented with flawed plans to spot problems and identify possible solutions.
